## Spinach Slaw

2 cups chopped iceberg lettuce 2 cups chopped red cabbage

2 cups chopped green cabbage

1½ cups fresh spinach

1/4 cup canola mayonnaise

1/4 cup hummus, original flavor

2 tablespoon local honey

1/2 teaspoon garlic powder

**1/8 teaspoon** salt

**1/8 teaspoon** pepper

1. Wash, quarter, and core lettuce, red cabbage mayonnaise, hummus, and green cabbage.

2. Thinly slice lettuce and cabbage quarters; chop slices into small pieces.

4. Whisk together

honey, garlic powder, salt and pepper until ingredients are mixed well. **Toss** dressing with vegetables until coated thoroughly. Refrigerate 3. Wash and tear spinach for 30 minutes before serving.




