



Honey Raisin Muffins

½ cup + 2 tablespoons all purpose flour

1/2 cup + 2 tablespoons whole wheat flour

34 teaspoon baking powder

1 teaspoon ground cinnamon

1/4 teaspoon baking soda

1/4 teaspoon salt

2 cups bran flake cereal with raisins

1 cup skim milk

1/2 cup honey

2 egg whites

3 tablespoons

unsweetened applesauce

2 tablespoons canola oil

1. Combine flours, baking powder, baking soda, cinnamon and salt in a bowl and set aside.

2. In a large mixing bowl, combine cereal, milk and honey; let stand for 2 minutes to soften. Stir

and oil; mix well. 3. Add dry ingredients and

stir until moistened.

4. Fill a greased or paperlined muffin pan 3/3 full.

5. Bake at 400°F for 15-18 minutes.

in egg whites, applesauce 6. Cool 10 minutes before removing from pan.

Yield: 12 muffins.
