Why is it important to make the most of mealtime? Children of families that share meals together have better academic performance, higher self-esteem, a greater sense of resilience, lower risk of teen pregnancy, lower risk of depression, lower rates of obesity, and a lower likelihood of developing an eating disorder. If children have better relationships with their parents and siblings, they are less likely to try drugs and alcohol.


